Decontamination Capability Protects Patients & Building

What Is It?

Outdoor Decontamination Shower for patients brought to the hospital for treatment for exposure to hazardous material, such as fuels, insecticides, meth lab residue, or other chemical or bio-hazard. The shower is outside the building, with a connecting entry to the ER.

Purposes

1. Cleanse the patient's skin or clothing of toxic substances.
2. Keep the contaminated material out of the hospital interior.

Features

The shower has multiple shower heads, privacy walls, and a containment pool to capture waste water. It uses a warm water supply. The EMS/Fire Brigade deploys two portable units to provide immediate patient decontamination at an incident scene. Nurses and medics don hazmat suits before assisting the patient. The treatment kit includes a radiation detector.
