MAINTENANCE ENGINEER HANDLES GROWING PHYSICAL PLANT

Hospital construction has abounded since 2008 (see below). That means more heating, air conditioning, electrical, plumbing, and ventilation systems under Clancy Hallum's care. The department of maintenance and engineering ensures that all systems are operating not just correctly, but also efficiently and safely. He is assisted by Dylan Bolton, maintenance technician, and various contractors. "We use local tradesmen in construction and repair to the extent possible," he said.

Hallum supervised the work of contractors on the following projects:

- Medical Clinic (enlarged to 9,000 sq. ft. from 6,000 sq. ft. in 2009)
- Therapy Building (3,500 sq. ft. opened in 2010)
- Adult Day Center (5,500 sq. ft. of renovated and new space opened in 2014)
- Social Services Building (2,200 sq. ft. opened in 2014)
- Emergency Department (enlarged to 4,550 sq. ft. from 1,200 sq. ft. in 2015)
- Growers Market Building (4,200 sq.ft. opened in 2016)
- Love County Legacy Park (10 acres, including paved walking trails opened in 2016)
- Food Pantry Building (enlarged to 1,500 sq.ft.from 750 sq.ft.in 2017)
- Maintenance Building and Work Vehicle Garage (6,300 sq. ft. opened in 2017)
