PPE

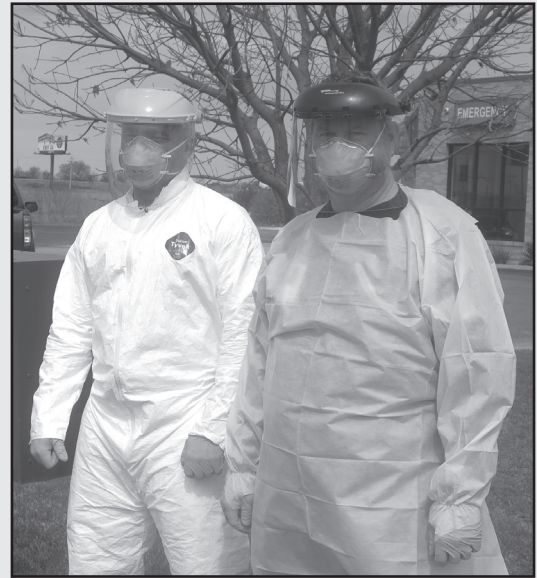
PPE stands for personal protective equipment. It is worn to minimize the spread of COVID-19 and keep healthcare workers (medics, doctors, nurses, and other caregivers) safe.

COVID-19 spreads by inhaling infectious cough or sneeze droplets. PPE for this risk consists of nitrile gloves, an N95 respirator mask, a face shield with side protection, and a gown (Manning) or barrier garment (Ramsey).

Most PPE is used only one time and by one person prior to disposal. To help with a localized surge of patients, Oklahoma hospitals share information each day about supplies of PPE.

The update goes out publicly in an Executive Order Report at <https://coronavirus.health.ok.gov/>. On April 19, for example, Love County reported having 3,000 surgical masks, 1,900 N95 masks, 100 gowns, 2,900 pairs of gloves, and 55 face-eye protectors.
